

2019 Four-Star Forward E.J. Liddell Commits to Ohio State Basketball



Chris Holtmann's second recruiting class is complete.

E.J. Liddell, a four-star forward out of Illinois, announced his commitment to Ohio State on Monday evening, rounding out a three-player class that includes five-star point guard DJ Carton and four-star small forward Alonzo Gaffney.

Liddell was a former Mr. Basketball in the state of Illinois and chose the Buckeyes over Missouri and Illinois. Liddell is ranked as the No. 48 overall player in the country and the top player in Illinois according to 247sports. All three of Ohio State's commitments are ranked in the top-50 in the country.
