

ESPN College GameDay's Lee Corso Picks Ohio State To Beat Penn State



ESPN's College GameDay was in University Park, Pa., this morning in anticipation of Ohio State's primetime tilt with Penn State (7:30 p.m. ET on ABC).

As the two-hour show wrapped up, analyst Lee Corso - surrounded by large Halloween yard ornaments and kids wearing costumes - pulled out Brutus Buckeye's headgear.

The first time Corso donned a mascot's headgear as part of his weekly predictions was Oct. 5, 1996, when he correctly predicted Ohio State's 38-7 win over Penn State.

This was the nation-leading 48th College GameDay appearance for Ohio State, which is 33-14 in games with the show on site. The Buckeyes will look to improve their record with a win over the Nittany Lions tonight.
