

Former Ohio State Forward Ibrahima Diallo Transfers To San Jose State



Former Ohio State forward Ibrahima Diallo has chosen his transfer location and will be joining San Jose State, according to Stadium's Jeff Goodman.

Ohio State big man transfer Ibrahima Diallo is headed to play at San Jose State for Tim Miles, source told @Stadium.

Diallo never was able to make a strong impact with the Buckeyes, finishing with 11 total points and 19 total rebounds across 13 appearances. The 6-10, 220-pound forward out of Saly, Senegal will now have three years of eligibility remaining due to a free year of eligibility last season.

The sophomore big man will be joining a San Jose State team that struggled mightily last season, finishing with a 5-16 record and a 3-13 record in the Mountain West. He will also be joining Tim Miles, who is coming in for his first season for the Spartans. Miles has been a head coach for more than two decades, most recently at Nebraska from 2012-19.
