

Garrett Accepts Invitation To Reese's Senior Bowl



Ohio State defensive tackle Haskell Garrett will represent the Buckeyes in the 2022 Reese's Senior Bowl.

The second-team Associated Press All-American and first-team All-Big Ten linemen returned to Ohio State with a final year of eligibility in 2021-22, leading the Buckeyes with 5 1/2 sacks and seven tackles for loss in the regular season.

Garrett recorded 62 tackles, 13 1/2 tackles for loss and 7 1/2 sacks in 31 total appearances for Ohio State. He also has one interception and two fumble recoveries in his career, one of which he returned for a touchdown in the season opener against Minnesota on Sept. 2.

The super senior will join defensive end Tyreke Smith and tight end Jeremy Ruckert at the Reese's Senior Bowl, which will take place on Feb. 5, 2022.
