



Ohio State's Pro Day Scheduled For March 25

Buckeye Sports Bulletin has learned Ohio State will hold its annual pro day at the Woody Hayes Athletic Center on March 25.

It's unclear at this time which former Buckeyes will participate in the event in front of NFL general managers, coaches and scouts or which teams will be in attendance, but potential participants include running back J.K. Dobbins; wide receivers K.J. Hill, Austin Mack and Binjimen Victor; offensive lineman Jonah Jackson; defensive end Chase Young; defensive tackle DaVon Hamilton; linebacker Malik Harrison; cornerbacks Damon Arnette and Jeff Okudah; and safety Jordan Fuller.

Those 11 players are also set to participate in the NFL Scouting Combine in Indianapolis, which runs from Feb. 23 through March 2.

Other former Ohio State players who were not invited to the combine but will likely participate in pro day include offensive lineman Branden Bowen, tight end Rashod Berry and defensive tackles Jashon Cornell and Robert Landers.

Approximately 130 personnel from all 32 NFL franchises attended last year's pro day at Ohio State, including general managers Brandon Beane (Buffalo Bills), Chris Grier (Miami Dolphins), Rick Spielman (Minnesota Vikings), Mike Mayock (Oakland Raiders) and John Lynch (San Francisco 49ers), as well as head coaches Zac Taylor (Cincinnati Bengals), Pat Shurmur (New York Giants), Mike Zimmer (Minnesota Vikings) and Jay Gruden (Washington Redskins). A similar turnout is expected next month.

The 2020 NFL Draft will be held April 23-25 in Las Vegas.
