

REPORT: Ryan Day Receives 5-Year Contract At Ohio State



On Jan. 2, 2019, Ryan Day will take over as Ohio State's head football coach.

Day, currently in his second season as the Buckeyes' offensive coordinator, has agreed to a five-year contract with Ohio State, according to a report by Bruce Feldman of Fox Sports.
